

## ONE WORD DEVOTIONAL

**Meditate:** Take about 5-7 minutes and meditate on these Scriptures.

**Ask:** What is the Spirit of Truth revealing to me?

**Pray:** Lord, I want to adjust my life to this truth. I want to obey You.

**Share:** In a group of 3-4 share what God is saying to you.

**SUFFER;** to experience or be subjected to (something bad or unpleasant).

### **Luke 24:26-27**

<sup>26</sup> Did not the Messiah have to suffer these things and then enter his glory?" <sup>27</sup> And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he explained to them what was said in all the Scriptures concerning himself.

### **Acts 9:16**

I will show him how much he must **suffer** for my name."

### **Romans 5:3-4**

<sup>3</sup> Not only so, but we <sup>[c]</sup> also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; <sup>4</sup> perseverance, character; and character, hope.

### **Romans 8:17-18**

<sup>17</sup> Now if we are children, then we are heirs—heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory. <sup>18</sup> I consider that our present sufferings are not worth comparing with the glory that will be revealed in us.

### **2 Corinthians 1:5**

For just as we share abundantly in the **sufferings** of Christ, so also our comfort abounds through Christ.

### **Philippians 1:29**

For it has been granted to you on behalf of Christ not only to believe in him, but also to **suffer** for him,

### **Colossians 1:24**

Now I rejoice in what I am **suffering** for you, and I fill up in my flesh what is still lacking in regard to Christ's afflictions, for the sake of his body, which is the church.

### **1 Peter 4:1**

Therefore, since Christ **suffered** in his body, arm yourselves also with the same attitude, because whoever **suffers** in the body is done with sin.
